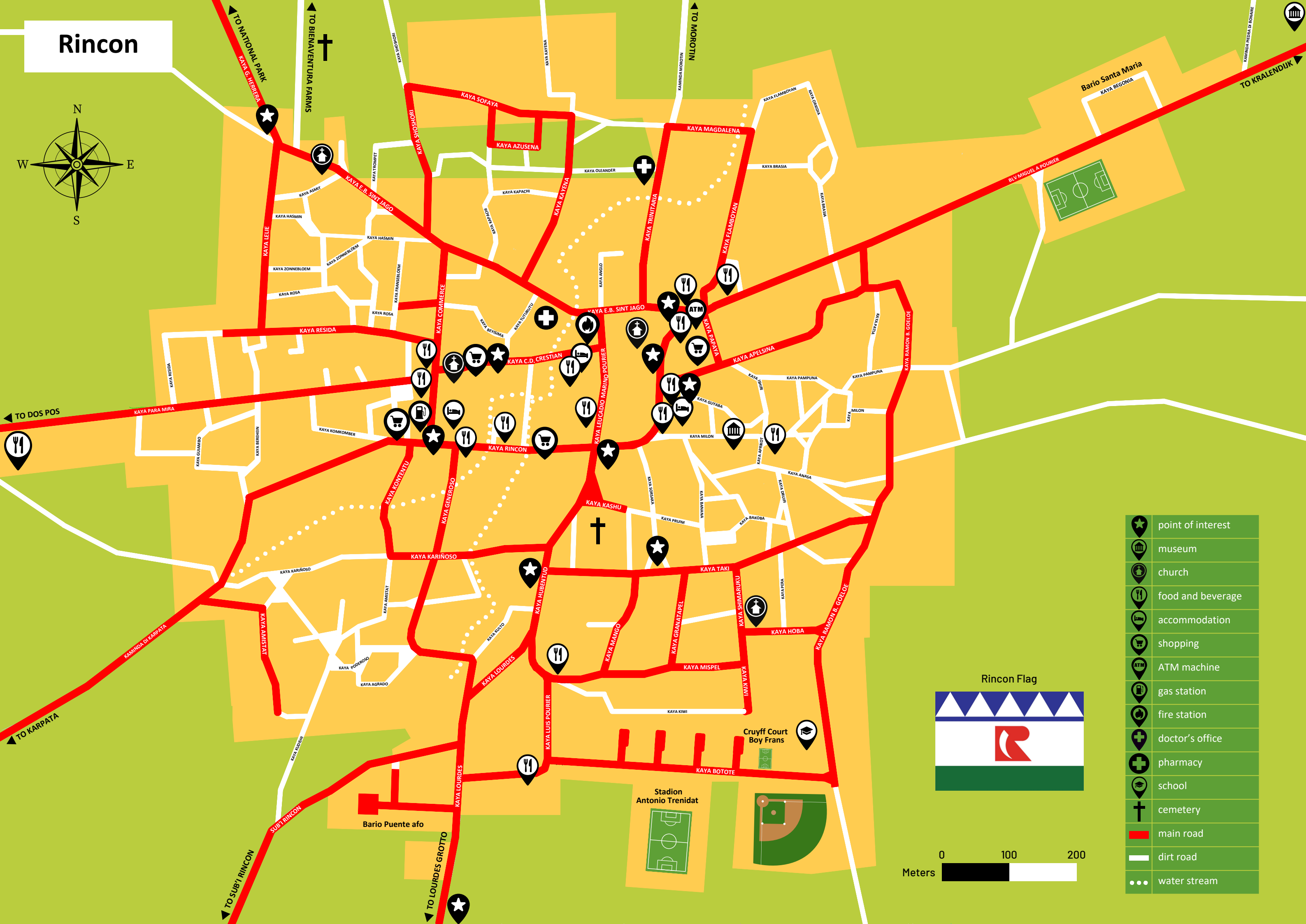
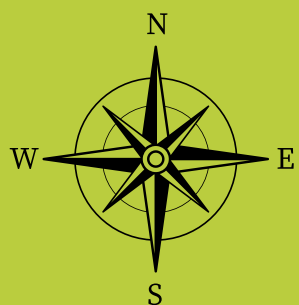

Facts about Rincon

A significant date for the people of Rincon and all Bonairians is April 30th, celebrated as Rincon Day. This date coincides with the birthday of Queen Juliana, in whose honor Queen Beatrix continued the tradition of celebrating Queen's Day on this day. The choice to celebrate Rincon Day on this date adds a layer of historical significance and continuity to the festivities.

In 1989, a group of Rincon residents initiated the celebration of Rincon Day as a cultural manifestation. Their vision was to showcase the traditional way of life in Rincon, showcasing and preserving the customs, practices, and values of the past. By doing so, they aimed to ensure that these cultural elements would be passed down to future generations and appreciated by the wider community.

Monuments

Julio Abraham Bust
Political leader and first president of the Partido Demokratiko Boneriano.



The Catholic Church
Constructed in 1837, the structure was designated as a parish in 1858.



The Rincon Sign
The signage was implemented along the main arterial road of Rincon.



Plenchi Tavio St. Jago
A venue that pays tribute to local music icons for their contributions in preserving the culture.



Plaza Bruchi Janga
At the cross road of the 4 quarters of Rincon, a dedication to a man who strived for Rincon.



Kas Schermer
The Schermer family's house has been restored and is now used by the community.



The Protestant Church
This church was constructed in 1937, the Rincon service operates bi-weekly.



Piedra Pretu
This monument marks the location where slaves gathered to immerse themselves in the rhythms of Bari music.



Rincon's Lourdes grotto
Inspired by Emma Pourier's visit to France, was blessed on December 11th, 1958.



Dr. J. G. Hernandez Bust
In honor of the revered physician, known as the "Doctor of the Poor."
